The car park surfacing and line marking team at Ross Solutions Projects has recently completed an important assignment at NHS Wycombe Hospital by turning a patch of adjoining wasteland into a fully-functioning 30-bay staff car park.

Located on an elevated position above Alexandra Road in High Wycombe, the hospital is the Buckinghamshire Healthcare Trust's main site for planned (or elective) surgery. Its services include specialist treatment for patients with heart conditions and strokes, a modern midwifery-led unit that complements the consultant-led maternity service at nearby Stoke Mandeville Hospital and an Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) for minor injuries and conditions.



The £50,000 project included levelling the rough ground and removing vegetation before applying a substrate of type 1 aggregate. Tarmac surfacing was laid and marked with parking bay divisions, kerbs and edging established and areas of light-coloured gravel were used to enhance the aesthetic landscaping of the car park. Concrete safety bollards were also installed around an existing utilities hut to complete the well-planned car park design.



Wycombe Hospital has four car parks allocated for patients and visitors, but this new car park represents a much needed facility for nursing and healthcare staff, including those from surrounding rural villages that suffer from a lack of regular public transport.
